
Each of us is a special note--Together we create a symphony

National Simultaneous Storytime (NSS) is an annual event that aims to engage children of all ages to enjoy books by creating a sense of excitement around reading. Reading ignites a spark of adventure that a child can carry within their heart well into their adult life.



GIVE ME SOME SPACE!

"Give me some Space" by Philip Bunting is the official story chosen for ALIA National Simultaneous Storytime 2021. On May 19th 2021 (11am AEST), this book will be read simultaneously to over 1 million children across Australia and New Zealand. Better still, Give Me Some Space! will be read live – by NASA astronaut Shannon Walker – from the International Space Station!

This week at St. Mary's, "Give me some Space" will be a key focus in many classrooms, supporting a range of reading, writing and art activities.

PAT: Progressive Achievement Tests

"More than two-thirds of all Australian schools use PAT to improve learning outcomes for every student"

Progressive Achievement Tests, commonly known as PATs, are one of the main sets of tests schools use. PATs are multiple-choice tests designed to help teachers determine achievement levels of students in Mathematics, Reading Comprehension and Vocabulary, and Listening Comprehension. During the month of May our Year 1-6 students complete PAT Reading, Maths, Spelling and Year 3-6 also complete the PAT Vocabulary, Grammar and Punctuation tests. These tests are completed online using Chromebooks and iPads. Data gathered will inform teachers of students' current strengths and areas for improvement which can be used for planning teaching and learning, and monitoring progress over time with PAT testing also conducted again in October

PAM Tip of the Week

Is your child going on a camp or excursion and you can't remember the details or what they need to bring?

- -Simply log into your PAM account
- -Select the child who is going on the camp, excursion etc
- -From the Profile Menu, select "School Activities"
- -Click "View" on the appropriate camp or excursion
- -You will be able to see all details, attachments etc in relation to the camp or activity



Leave Passes

If you need to collect your child for an appointment or take them home early during the school day, please come to the school office to collect a leave pass. You will then be able to go to your child's classroom to pick them up (it is not necessary to phone the school before picking them up). If the child returns to school after their appointment, they need to collect a pass from the office before returning to their classroom. Just a reminder to please arrange appointments outside of school hours wherever possible.
