Out of School Hours Program

Our plans for an Out of School Hours Care Service have become a reality with the new service opening TODAY! The program is operating out of the gym hub and will provide **before and after school care** for school age children for children in the Swan Hill area. We have been very fortunate to have been approved as the third party provider for Swan Hill North Primary School who successfully applied for, and were granted out of school hours program establishment funding. This means that students from both Swan Hill North Primary

School and St Mary's will access and benefit from this new service. New Sacramental Dates for Confirmation & Eucharist

Now that restrictions have eased to a point where we are able to gather together in the Church again we are very excited to share our new Sacramental Dates with families. Please find below Sacramental Dates for this term:

Year 3 Confirmation - 24th/25th July Year 5 Eucharist - 31st/1st August Year 4 Confirmation & Eucharist (combined) - 7th/8th August

This week we will be sending home a letter explaining these changes and for families to choose which Mass they will be attending. If you could please send these back as soon as possible and make contact with me at school if you need to discuss this further. We have also sent home preparation booklets last term for our Year 4 & 5 children undertaking their First Eucharist in the next few weeks.

Within the preparation packs it is broken up into 4 sessions to work through -

Session 1 - Celebrating Being Christian

Session 2 - Remembering Jesus

Session 3 - Jesus Present

Session 4 - Called and Sent Out

Hopefully over the holidays your child had the chance to work through Session 1 which focused on different celebrations that we celebrated together with our families. This week the focus for your child might be to work through Session 2 which explores the theme of the 'Eucharist' - A special meal recalling the events of the Last Supper. Jesus often shared meals with his friends and on the night before he died he shared a very special meal with his disciples, giving them the gift of his life through the form of bread and wine.

Bus changes now available on PAM

You are now able to make bus changes via your PAM account. This includes bus passes, not on bus, change of bus etc. **SkoolBag is no longer to be used for Bus Changes.**

- Log in to your PAM account.
- From the hamburger menu in the top right hand corner, select "Transport Passes".
- Ensure the date is correct, displayed above the student schedule table.
- Click on the "Edit" button of the child you wish to add/remove from a bus.
- "Select New Route" will allow you to add your child to a bus, add your child to a different bus or select "No transport needed" if your child is not to travel on the bus on that particular day.

Bus changes via PAM must be made by 2.30pm. Need assistance, please call the office on 50332541.



CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

Applications for CSEF close on Friday 13th August.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child. The annual CSEF amount per student is \$125 for primary school students.

HOW TO APPLY:

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from:

www.education.vic.gov.au/Documents/about/programs/health/CSEF-Application-Form-2020.pdf.


If you applied for the CSEF at your child's school in 2020, you do not need to complete an application form in 2021 unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- new student enrolments; your child has started or changed schools in 2020 or you did not apply in 2020
- changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing at the school in 2021.

If you are unsure please contact the school office on 50332541.

If you are eligible for CSEF you are also eligible for the Family Fee Assistance Scheme. The FFAS amount for 2021 is \$850.00. This amount is credited against your school fee account once your CSEF application has been validated.
