The first few weeks

In the first few weeks of this year we focus on "Learning To Learn" at St Mary's. Time is spent on creating a safe and supportive learning environment, getting to know all students' DNA (Dreams, Needs and Abilities) and on establishing learning routines and expectations. There is also a strong emphasis on developing a culture of understanding and respect for each other in our school, supporting children to build their skills of resilience, have a growth mindset and relish taking on challenges. Across the classes we are discussing the different kinds of learning dispositions that we can develop and how we can live out the St Mary's Way.

Meet the Teacher Chats

We have Meet the teacher Chats this week Tuesday February 8th & Wednesday February 9th. The details for booking a time have been emailed to you via PAM and if you have any trouble making a booking please phone the office. These have

been set early in the term to provide an opportunity for all parents to touch base with staff by phone, share information about your child and together to set educational goals for the term ahead. I strongly encourage all families to take up this opportunity to book a time to chat with your child's teacher. It is a great way to connect and partner in your child's learning journey . We will return to onsite Student Led and 3 Way conferences in following interviews, as restrictions ease.



COVID Update

Thank you for the calm and sensible approach taken by families regarding the latest restrictions and requirements. It has been terrific to return to school without COVID dominating our start of year activities and classrooms this year. Our students in Year 3-6 have been fantastic at wearing their masks indoors and thank you to parents for being so organised and sending the children along to school with a mask each day. As masks need replacing (or washing) could I ask our parents of Year 3-6 students to regularly please check your child's bag and ensure they have sufficient supplies of masks each week. Just a reminder about the key Rapid Antigen Testing (RAT) information

- Free RATS are available for all students at St Mary's School for the first 4 weeks of school. We will advise about the distribution arrangements for the Week 3-4 kits when they arrive
- Testing is voluntary
- Students are requested to test twice weekly with most families reporting that they are testing Sunday and Tuesday nights.
- Tests are provided in packs of 5 individual nasal tests
- Masks are mandatory for Students in Yr 3-6, unless a lawful exemption applies.

Friday Assembly Update

Friday assemblies are held in the gym and are an opportunity to celebrate the week at school. Each Friday assembly is run by a different class who lead us in prayer and we like to enjoy a whole school sing along at these gatherings as well. Many family and friends attend assembly and often stay on and share lunch with their child in our playground.

COVID restrictions affecting numbers and indoor gatherings have placed some limits on our normal practices, so we are holding Friday assemblies **remotely** for the first 4 weeks of school. We will then reassess and advise if we can recommence indoor assemblies as a school community and if family and friends are able to attend. From Friday **February 18th**, families are warmly invited to join us for lunch in our passive play area any Friday. The only requirements are you must QR code and show proof of being fully vaccinated to a member of the office staff on your way in.



Bus Travel Reminder

Our bus schedules have rolled over from 2021, if you have made any <u>changes to your bus travel arrangements for 2022</u>, please contact the office on 50332541.

Also, a reminder to our Foundation families, if your child will be catching a bus, please advise the office of a start date, even if they have older siblings at school. This helps to

ensure our records are up to date and to make sure each child has a buddy to assist them with bus travel.

Our Learning to Learn units at the start of the year focus on teaching and modelling 'The St Mary's Way' and set up the classroom so that relationships are developed and learning can take place in a positive way.

This week marks the start of our first Blitz, which is a focus on a positive behaviour we would like to strengthen in our school community. Our first blitz is on Positive Greetings was we know how powerful and affirming a cheery hello and acknowledgement from others can be. If you are in the yard at all I hope you receive many smiles, helios and greetings as we practice and reinforce this very important life skill.

Open Water Swimming

The Year 3's and 4's really enjoyed their Open Water Swimming Experience held at Lake Boga last week on Thursday and Friday. While the water was a little chilly, they have learned some valuable skills in how to be safe around open water. Swimming Trials

The St. Mary's Swimming Trials will be held on Thursday, 10th of February at the Swan Hill Swimming Pool beginning at 1.00pm for those children in year 3-6 that have expressed interest. On this day, each child who wishes to participate will be given the opportunity to swim in the stroke(s) that they have nominated. We will simply record their time for each nominated stroke to determine the fastest 2 swimmers for each event in each age group.

The trials are open to children who must be turning 9 or older this year and must be confident to swim <u>50m</u> without stopping.

A note will go home this week to confirm your child's participation and parent helpers. Please ensure PAM permission is given for your child to attend.

School Sport Victoria (SSV) State Team Trials

Students who turn 10, 11 or 12 in 2022 have the opportunity to register to trial for the State SSV teams for 2022. The trials are held in Swan Hill in April/May 2022. (Trials dates are listed on the Mallee Division website, all held between 4.00-5.00pm at local venues)

Important information

- 1. Main Sports are AFL Football, Netball, Soccer and Basketball.
- 2. Students can register for Hockey, Triathlon and Volleyball trials, but these trials are not held in Swan Hill.
- 3. Students need to be 'talented' at their chosen sports. These trials are not come and try events.
- 4. Online Registrations on the SSV State Website. http://www.ssv.vic.edu.au opened Wednesday, 1st December 2021 and close Tuesday 1st March 2022. (no late entries accepted after that date) There is a one off fee per sport which is non-refundable.
- 5. A student can register for more than one sport but would have to pay a fee for each sport they select.
- 6. Each school can register up to 3 children to trial for a particular sport. If there are more than 3 who register then schools must do their own trial before the division level.
- 7. Students must get their Principal and the School Sports Rep Permission to trial.
- 8. If they are selected to progress from the Swan Hill trials, students then move on to trial against students from across the Loddon Mallee Region. There are quite a few levels of trials before the final teams are selected.

School Fees 2022

We have calculated the school fees for 2022, these have been emailed or posted out. If you would like assistance setting up a direct debit or have any questions or queries about the fees please contact the office, we are more than happy to discuss them.

Camps, Sports & Excursions Fund (CSEF)

Applications for CSEF close on 24th June 2022.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child. The annual CSEF amount per student is \$125 for primary school students.

HOW TO APPLY:

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from the CSEF website.

If you applied for the CSEF at your child's school in 2021, you do not need to complete an application form in 2022 unless there has been a change in your family circumstances. You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- new student enrolments; your child has started or changed schools in 2022 or you did not apply in 2021
- changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing at the school in 2022.

If you are unsure please contact the school office on 50332541.

If you are eligible for CSEF you are also eligible for the Family Fee Assistance Scheme. The FFAS amount for 2022 is \$850.00. This amount is credited against your school fee account once your CSEF application has been validated.


