#### **Senior Cross Country**

Thanks to Miss Clark and the Year 6 House Captains for their organisation and encouragement of all the children and it was wonderful to witness so many students and staff out there walking or running laps for their respective teams. The Senior Cross Country took place at Riverside Park **today** and it was terrific to see a big turn out of supporters to cheer the runners on.

#### NAPLAN starting Tuesday May 10th

This week, students in Year 3 and 5 will undertake the new online NAPLAN tests. NAPLAN is a point-in-time assessment that allows parents to see how their child is progressing in Literacy and Mathematics against the national standard and compared with their peers throughout Australia. The NAPLAN tests assess knowledge and skills in Literacy and Numeracy. The results of these tests provide information to teachers and parents which can be then used to support the teaching and learning programs. By analysing results, teachers can adjust teaching strategies to provide appropriate support or identify students who would benefit from enrichment activities.

The best way you can help your child prepare for NAPLAN is to reassure them that NAPLAN tests are just one part of their school program and to advise them to do the best they can on the day. Ensure your child has had proper rest and has a healthy snack and lunch as usual. Students who are funded under Special Needs may be exempted from completing the NAPLAN tests. **Parents/Guardians who do not want their child to sit the test, please contact the school for an Exemption form.** Parents/ Guardians need to contact contact their childs teacher, Ginny Gook or myself if they wish to withdraw their child from any of the NAPLAN tests. The Naplan timetable was sent via PAM earlier this term.
