






Flying Bookworm Performance

Curriculum News - Mrs Hall

Sunshine Online/Classic, Reading Eggs and Phonics Hero

At St. Mary's we are very fortunate to have many subscriptions to support our students in the area of Literacy and Numeracy which are great engaging resources to utilize out of school hours. Sunshine Online which is a wonderful website containing hundreds of levelled texts. Children can log in and read along to stories and then complete associated interactive games and activities. Students enjoy using this website and it is a fun and motivational way to keep the "reading miles".

We also have a subscription to **Sunshine Classics** which is another digital literacy program with over 300 E- books and 1000 interactive language activities to enjoy

Our Year 1 children have individualised log in codes for <u>Reading Eggs</u>. Designed by literacy experts, Reading Eggs makes learning essential literacy skills easy and fun for younger children. Foundations are supported by the <u>Phonics Hero</u> subscription with the focus on phonics, reading and spelling online interactive games.

Mathletics and Mathseeds

In the area of Mathematics, the Year 2-6 students have individualised logs in for <u>Mathletics</u>. Mathletics provides learners with the chance to put their mathematics skills to use through activities and challenges. Students have access to relevant content set by their teachers that will reinforce their learning and challenge them to go to the next level. Yr 1's have access to <u>Mathseeds</u>. Mathseeds teaches kids aged 3-9 core maths and problem solving skills with fun online maths games and activities.

PAM (Parent Access Module) - Tip of the Week

PAM is St Mary's main communication platform. All school related information is sent through PAM, so it is important to check your emails regularly. All communication via PAM will be sent to the email address linked to your PAM account. Please also check your spam/junk mail as sometimes these emails will go to this folder. Just mark the email "not spam/junk" and emails should then begin to appear in your inbox.



<u>Excursions & School Activity Permissions</u> - you will receive an email notification advising you have a new "school activity permission" available to view. There will be a link to access this through PAM.

Click on this link, this will take you to PAM, log in and in the top right hand corner on the "bell" will be a red dot with a number inside. These are your notifications. Click to view school activity permission details. Consent is given by scrolling to the bottom of the school activity details. The red numbered dot will disappear once the school activity permission has been opened or the date for consent has passed.

You can view past permissions or those you have already given consent for by clicking on the student, select profile menu, select "School Activities".

Book Club - Issue 4


Scholastic Book Club Issue 4 has been sent home. <u>We will not be accepting cash payments for orders</u>. Please order online following the instructions below.
