Child Safety- Drop off times in the morning

A teachers day starts far earlier than 8.55 am when the bell goes. Prior to 8.30am, they are either in meetings with members of the leadership or wellbeing teams, responding to parent phone calls or emails or preparing for their work day ahead. Our staff all get to



work early to ensure that when head to class and open their doors at 8.30 am, they are fully present to spend time with their students as they arrive.
